OAR Spay it Forward

OAR's Spay it Forward fund is made possible by gracious private donors. Often added on to the cost of their own pet's spay or neuter surgery, these donations "spay it forward" to a pet in need. Because this program is funded by donations, availability may be limited.

# The Spay it Forward program reduces the cost of surgery and a rabies vaccine to \$40 for qualifying pet owners.

Eligibility

- 1. You must have an appointment for spay/neuter of an owned pet.
- 2. You must live within 50 miles of Ohio Alleycat Resource.
- 3. You must provide documentation showing proof of public assistance (WIC, food stamps, SSDI) or present documentation demonstrating a household income at or below the threshold listed below. Documentation may be presented at the time of drop off. Please do not email photos of documents showing private, personal information to OAR.



#### **Ohio Only**

Butler County Spay/Neuter Initiative 2022-2023

The Butler County Spay/Neuter Initiative is made possible in part by a grant from Petco. This program reduces the cost of surgery and rabies vaccine to \$25 for qualifying pet owners.

Eligibility

- 1. You must have an appointment for spay/neuter of an owned pet.
- 2. You must be a resident of Butler Co, Ohio.
- 3. You must provide documentation showing proof of public assistance (WIC, food stamps, SSDI) or present documentation demonstrating a household income at or below the threshold listed below. Documentation may be presented at the time of drop off. Please do not email photos of documents showing private, personal information to OAR.



#### **Kentucky Only**

NKADD Regional Spay & Neuter Program
NKADD funds reduced cost spay/neuter to reduce the number of cats in
NKY counties. The NKADD program reduces the cost of surgery and
rabies vaccine to \$30 for qualifying pet owners.
Eligibility

- 1. You must live in Boone, Campbell, Carroll, Gallatin, Grant, Kenton, Owen, or Pendleton county.
- 2. You must provide documentation showing proof of public assistance (i.e. WIC, food stamps, SSDI) or present documentation demonstrating a household income at or below the threshold listed below. Documentation may be presented at the time of drop off.
